## Our Program's Mission

The purpose of Huntsville Hospital's CME program is to promote continuous improvement in patient care by providing education activities for physicians. The activities will update physicians on new diagnosis and treatment modalities, improve clinical skills, improve physicians' compliance with quality management issues, and promote cost effective quality care.
